There have been some high profile incidents in professional golf recently involving the rules of golf. A good knowledge of the rules can add to your enjoyment of the game and maybe even improve your score.

Golf Manitoba is once again offering its popular Rules of Golf Level 3 Seminar this fall. It is a one night and two day in-class and on-course presentation of the rules. On the third day, there is an optional exam if you wish to test your knowledge of the rules and/or want to certify as a Golf Manitoba Rules Official.

No prior rules experience is necessary however you should read the rules book in advance of the seminar and if you are planning to certify to become a rules official, please obtain the Course Preparation Manual from the Golf Manitoba Office in advance of the seminar.

There is no charge for the seminar.

## DID YOU KNOW?

- Golf Manitoba conducts approximately 10 to 20 course & slope ratings annually.
- Course & slope rating is based on a number of factors such as course length, fairway width, out of bounds & extreme rough, green speed, course topography and hazards.
- Slope rating is defined as the measurement of the relative difficulty of a course for players who are not scratch golfers compared to those that are scratch. The lowest slope rating possible is 55 and the highest is 155. A course with a higher slope rating will be more difficult for a bogey golfer than it will be for a scratch golfer.
- Course rating is the evaluation of the playing difficulty of a course for a scratch golfer under normal course and weather conditions. Course rating is an indicator of course difficulty.
- The use of a course and slope rating is a privilege of membership in Golf Manitoba and Golf Canada as these rating systems are trade-marked and subject to licensing requirements. Non-member courses are not permitted to use these trademarks.
