2011 MANITOBA GOLF HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

The Manitoba Golf Hall of Fame & Museum Inc. will hold its ninth annual induction ceremony, presented by the McPhillips Station Casino, Manitoba Lotteries, on Monday, September 26th, 2011 at the McPhillips Station Casino.



Gary Kullman and **Judi Lidstone** will be inducted as Honoured Members in the Athlete category. **Derek Ingram** will be inducted as an Athlete/Builder and **Walter Perchaylo** will join them in the Builder category.

"We are proud to support the Manitoba Golf Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony for a ninth consecutive year," said Manitoba Lotteries President and CEO, Winston Hodgins. "Honouring the inductees enriches an already enduring legacy, celebrates the sport and the many achievements of those who have shown great passion for the game".

In addition to the annual inductions, the Golf Hall of Fame takes a leading role in promoting knowledge about Manitoba's rich golfing history, including the accomplishments of members of the Golf Hall of Fame, as well as assisting golf clubs in preserving their heritage.

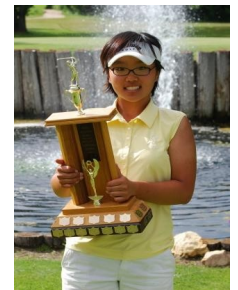

WESTERN CANADA GAMES TEAM DECIDED FOLLOWING JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

For the first time, golf will be a participating sport in the 2011 Western Canada Summer Games. Golf Manitoba has been training approximately 30 boys and girls 16 years old and younger since January of this year in preparation for the Games. The training included weekly practices at The Golf Dome, strength and conditioning with personal trainers, sport psych discussions and dietary consultations.



The boys and girls teams were chosen based on eight competitive rounds with the players counting their six best scores for their cumulative total. The Provincial Junior Championships were the final rounds in the calculation.

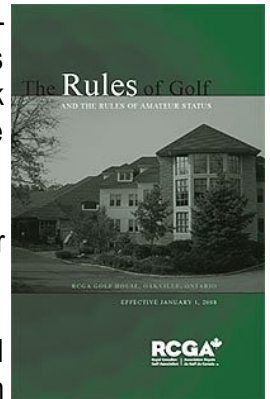
THANK YOU!

DID YOU KNOW?

Rules of Golf Education is now available in a four level series that can be done at your own pace. The following is an overview of the levels:

- Level One - Available online at <http://rulesofgolf.golfcanada.ca/>. It is a fully web-based program that is meant to act as an initial stepping stone into the Rules of Golf 4-level program. It is no-cost to go through the entire Level 1 program, however, to gain access to the exam the cost is \$6.99 for members and \$9.99 for non-members. That cost includes a copy of the Rules book that will be shipped to you. Similar to the Level 2 online program, a person can go through the content at their own pace and write the exam when they feel ready.
- Level Two – Also available on-line at a cost of \$49.99 for non-members and \$34.90 for members. Again, you can proceed through it at your own pace at write the exam when ready.
- Level Three – Level Three is a seminar conducted by Golf Manitoba. We encourage all participants to be Level Two certified but it is not mandatory. We have conducted this seminar in both the spring and the fall with the last one taking place this past spring. Details on the next seminar will be posted on our website once confirmed.
- Level Four – Conducted by the Royal Canadian Golf Association (Golf Canada). Manitoba will host a national seminar every three years.

If you wish to develop your knowledge of the rules even further and become a rules official, on-site training is a wonderful way to gain experience with the rules. Golf Manitoba conducts a number of events each year where we have rules officials being trained. These people are usually riding on a power cart with a more experienced official with the goal of learning how to deal with players, rules situations, etc.
