The Sport for Life Center is being developed to house all provincial sport associations under one roof in a state of the art facility that will eventually include such things as athletic training facilities, the Manitoba Sport Hall of Fame and Museum, administrative sport offices, sport science labs, board rooms and media and conference centers.
