GOLF MANITOBA TOURNAMENT POLICIES

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

All information for specific tournaments, such as information regarding pairings and starting times will be available on the Golf Manitoba web site approximately 5 – 7 days before the tournament commences. Email notification of pairings and starting times will be sent to players who have supplied valid email addresses.

It is the competitor's sole responsibility to determine his/her starting time.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

All Golf Manitoba tournaments are conducted using the Standard Local Rules and Conditions of the Competition adopted by Golf Manitoba. Copies of these documents are available on the Golf Manitoba web site, the Golf Manitoba office and copies are available to all players at the tournament.

ELIGIBILITY

All competitors must be a member of a recognized provincial, state or national golf association. The membership card **must** be current and be available for presentation at the registration table along with a print out of your handicap report signed by a club official.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

All Entries must be submitted by completing the Entry Form in full. Incomplete entries may be rejected. Entries will be processed on a first received basis. **It is the player's responsibility to ensure entries arrive at the Golf Manitoba office on time.** Please check the Golf Manitoba web site to ensure your entry has been received. Golf Manitoba does not assume responsibility for entries lost in the mail or by courier.

Payment in full must accompany the Entry Form. Cheques must be dated no later than the closing date of any event being entered. Cheques are to be made payable to: **"Golf Manitoba"**, and mailed to the Association at: **145 Pacific Avenue, Winnipeg, Manitoba R3B 2Z6**. NSF cheques are subject to a \$20.00 charge plus any financial institution charge.

NO TELEPHONE OR FAX ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

WITHDRAWALS

Any player who fails to notify Golf Manitoba with a valid reason for withdrawing prior to commencement of the event, or who withdraws during play without valid reason, or who fails to appear for a subsequent round of an event, may be suspended from competing in any Golf Manitoba events for the balance of the current season, as well as for the next season. Should a competitor be forced to withdraw from an event, he/she must inform a Golf Manitoba Official at the earliest possible opportunity. **In addition, a 24-hour telephone answering service is available to accept notification of emergency withdrawals. Call 925-5730.**

REFUND POLICY

Entry fees will not be refunded after the entry closing date. Tournament entry fees, less a \$20.00 service charge, will be refunded when Golf Manitoba is notified by phone or email prior to the entry deadline of the tournament. Refunds, less the service charge, will be given only for medical or compassionate reasons for a cancellation received after the tournament entry deadline. Such cancellations require written confirmation. No refund will be given for any reason once the tournament begins.

POWER CARTS AND CADDIES

Automotive carts are not permitted in the junior events, the Men's Amateur Championship (includes Qualifying round), the Women's Amateur Championship and the Men's Mid-Amateur Championship. Golf Manitoba can allow, in exceptional circumstances, use of a power cart or other special equipment by a player who otherwise qualified for an amateur event and cannot, in the opinion of the Tournament Committee, participate in such a competition because of a serious permanent physical impairment. Such use can be denied if the Tournament Committee believes that the use of such a power cart, or other special equipment, would give a player an undue advantage over other players in the competition.

Requests for the use of a power cart must be submitted by the tournament entry deadline. Requests after the deadline will not be considered.

Please refer to the Golf Manitoba Automotive Transportation Policy for further details.

Advance arrangements with the Host Club for pull carts or automotive carts are the responsibility of the competitor.

Caddies are not permitted in the junior events.

CONDUCT

Entrants are warned that conduct considered detrimental to the best interests of the game, or unbecoming of a contestant, either on or off the golf course, and coming to the attention of the Tournament Committee, will be strictly dealt with, and can result in disqualification of the offending person(s). Please refer to the Golf Manitoba Code of Conduct for further details.

The use of alcohol or tobacco products on the tournament site by junior aged competitors is not permitted.

RULES OF GOLF

Play in all Golf Manitoba events will be governed by the Rules of Golf as approved for use in Canada by the Royal Canadian Golf Association. Retrogression will be in accordance with the 2008 RCGA Handicap System publication. All questions will be settled by the Tournament Committee of Golf Manitoba.

PLAYOFFS

If, in the sole opinion of the Tournament Committee, a playoff is not feasible, a system of retrogression will be used to break ties.

Entrants must not have reached their 15th birthday by the **last** scheduled day of the RCGA championship, August 6th, 2010.
Women's Junior Bantam eligibility
Handicap Factor of 36.0 or less

Eligibility: Handicap Factor of 36.0 or less
Entrants must not have reached their 19th birthday by the **last** scheduled day of the RCGA championship, August 6th, 2010.
Provincial Team: The low four competitors after 54 holes of the Championship will comprise the Manitoba Provincial Junior Team. A playoff for fourth place, if necessary will be conducted on a sudden victory basis.
Deadline: July 6 at 1:00 p.m.
